**Rose Ann McDonald** discussed the Spring Kaufman Benefit to be held on March 22. The committee is working on an Easter Egg Hunt plus other

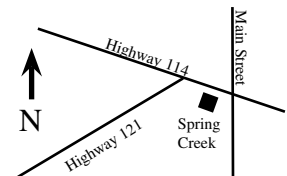

Unless otherwise noted, other rides leave from the Chevron/McDonalds on the corner of Highway 114 and Main Street in Grapevine.

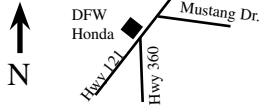
