Ken Frazer (Vice-President) then discussed several upcoming rides and events:

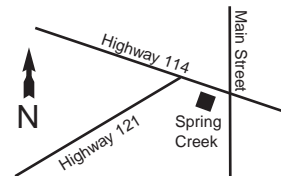

Mobil 1 Disappeared?

I checked what was going on with the so called Mobil 1 "Red Cap" disappearance. Well, it has not. What has happened is Mobil has upgraded all of their motor oils for all applications. What often times happens when this occurs is the package, or label, or colors of the package can be changed. Mobil has done this. They now have the color of the cap designate the "line of motor oils" where before the color of the caps designated the "grade of motor oils". Ok, what is the difference? The grade of motor oil is whether it is a 5W-30, 10W-30, or 15W-50. We used to look for the "red cap" on the 15W-50 Mobil 1 motor oil. Now the "red cap" on the new mobil line represents their line of mineral oils, all grades from 5W-30 on up.

The new Mobil 1 line of motor oils is represented by the gold cap, and for all grades from 5W-30 on up to 15W-50. I presume that the gold cap was picked to represent their top

of the line. Just look for the gold cap, then look at the label with a "red" color behind the grade designation of 15W-50. See, the red still exists after all.

Run for the Wall Texas Leg

May 22, 2005

Run for the Wall from Ontario, CA to DC, with a Central and Southern corridor. The Southern corridor will arrive Weatherford, TX around

5:40 p.m., Saturday, May 21 and depart there at 8 a.m. Sunday morning May 22. They have several web-sites, including <http://www.rftw.org/Southern/> or simply www.rftw.2005.org. This group will form up in D.C. and become a parade known as "Rolling Thunder". This will be the 18th year for RT, and they amassed 500,000 bikes in D.C on Sunday May 30, 2004. There is no charge for this ride.

We only rode from Weatherford to Terrell with them last year, as "day riders", but it was enough to get all of us fired up for a longer ride this year! They welcome any and all riders and vehicles, no matter whether or not anyone has been in the military. They even had an eighteen wheeler join up with them a while back. To say the least, this is a "moving" experience, particularly when they leave the interstate and ride thru the national cemetery in Grand Prairie.

D/FW Freedom Riders Southern States Run

May 22 - 29, 2005

This is a two-part ride, scheduled to coordinate with the annual, national Run for the Wall (www.rftw.org). We will ride with them and partake of their functions, etc; until they reach Chattanooga, Tennessee. At that point, we will then become our own ride, and after enjoying some of the best bike roads in the U.S., returning to the D/FW area.

THERE IS NO CHARGE TO GO ON RFTW, However, each participant is responsible for all personal expenses, medical information and bike disposition. Through the generosity of many people, we have many donated meals, gas, camping,

etc. at some stops. However, each participant is responsible for all personal expenses. Support and chase vehicles are available for breakdowns at no cost. Your purchase of merchandise, 50-50 drawings, and donations provide the funds for chase trucks.

Segment 1 - RFTW

We will join up with the RFTW folks at their stop in Weatherford. They will be arriving in Weatherford the evening of Saturday, May 21, and leaving the morning of Sunday, May 22. We will ride with them to Chattanooga Tennessee, on the evening of Tuesday, May 24. Throughout this portion of the ride, they have events that take place along the way. For instance, some of the things they've done in the past is to tour the national cemetery in Grand Prairie, make VA Hospital visits, etc. Once I get more details from them on their daily specifics, I will let everyone know.

Segment 2 - On Our Own

While riding with the RFTW we will traverse many a mile of Interstate highway, but for the three days from May 25th, through May 27, it will seem worth it as we will not see a straight stretch of road the entire time. After leaving the RFTW in Chattanooga, we will ride through Tennessee, western Virginia, and on back toward home, returning to the Dallas area on Sunday, May 29.

Some of the planned riding points of interest during this segment will be Deals Gap (318 turns in 11 miles), Smoky Mountains National Park, Cherohala Skyway, and others; with some shopping along the way. During our return home we will also travel through the mountains of NW Georgia and stop in a wonderful German town, Helen (LOTS of shopping - ask Pam!).

But alas, we must return home at some point and after lunch and some shopping in Helen, we will hook 'em back to Texas via Interstate 20. One

last evening of fun is planned for Saturday, 5/28; we will be staying at the Isle of Capri Casino and Hotel. If we have time on Sunday, we may leave I-20 and travel US 80 for a while, connect with I-30 and come back into town that way.

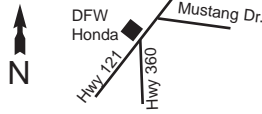
